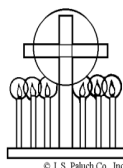

**THE DAY OF THE LORD**

Pope John Paul II wrote a beautiful teaching on the day of the Lord or Sunday and its meaning for disciples of Christ. One thing we can learn from his teaching is the importance of Sunday and the Sacrifice of the Mass is the central aspect of the day. In other words the Eucharist must be the heart of the day and not just part of the day. This can help us tremendously as we consider changing the Mass schedule at Word of God and Madonna del Castello Parishes. If Mass is the core of what we do for the Lord as His disciples on Sunday then perhaps other activities can be given their proper priority and adjusted appropriately.
