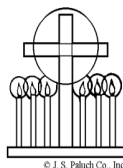

PASTORAL COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

The meeting on October 25 was opened with a prayer by Fr. John. Some of the points discussed were:

- Review of 90th Anniversary Mass—A lot of positive feedback. Still extra stamps available as well as favor packages & t-shirts.
- Suggestion made to move all sign ups and ticket sales to social hall. We have recently refurbished the back of the church to make it a more prayerful space. It would be better for us to conduct all business in social hall. All agreed.
- Should electric candles remain? Possible solutions—remove or cover.
- Parish member wants to donate a statue for outside the church. Also, Fr. John asked how we felt about a scripture quote on our outside sign. All agreed.
- Question about changing carrier (Verizon & Comcast) and should we change the church phone number—no consensus.
- Fr. John mentioned that we just recently started a St. Vincent de Paul group to help people in need. More information will follow in the next few weeks.
- The church still has patons, should we begin to use them again? People could become more reverent of the precious body and Blood of Christ. All members were in favor.
- Election Day—should we have extended adoration? Possibly have Ladies of Charity make calls to be sure that people sign up. How can we take more of a stand on the political views? Can we send letters to candidates who are pro-abortion?
- CCD news—should we have another Family Fun Night? Should we also encourage a family prayer night (possibly going to Holy Hour and then having a social afterwards). Should it be extended to all families?
- Certificate of Appreciation—question asked if we should consider doing something like this for our elderly.
- Ladies of Charity would like to promote more members. Could possibly ask in the bulletin regarding ideas to reach out to parish.
