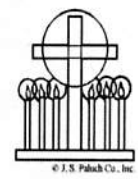

### LADIES OF CHARITY

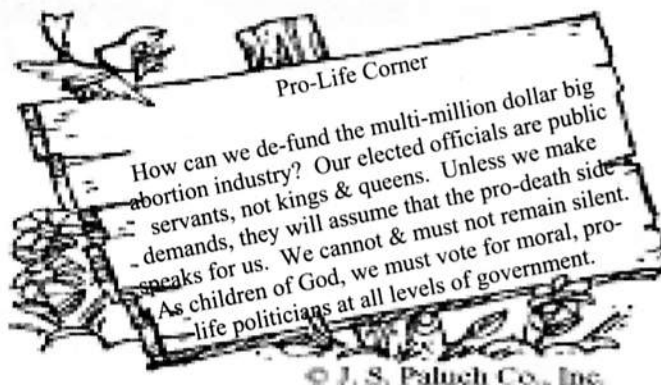
