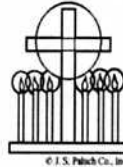

SISTERS OF CHARITY

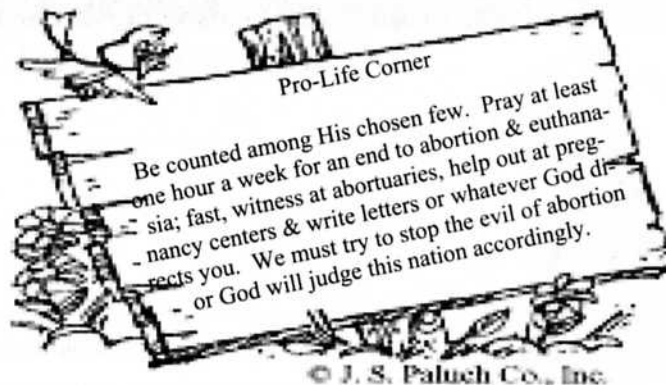
