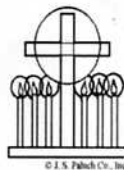

### LAROCHE COLLEGE OPEN HOUSE

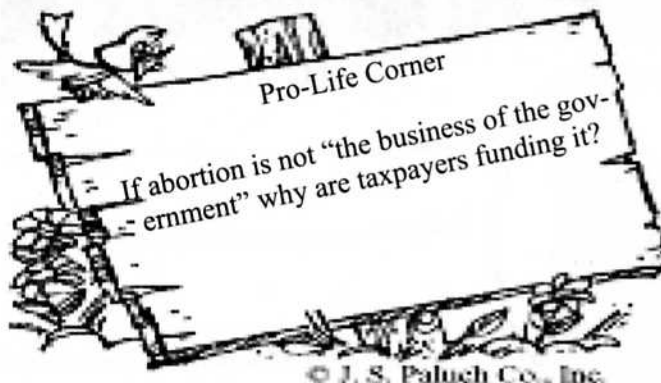
