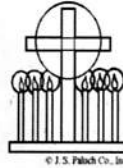

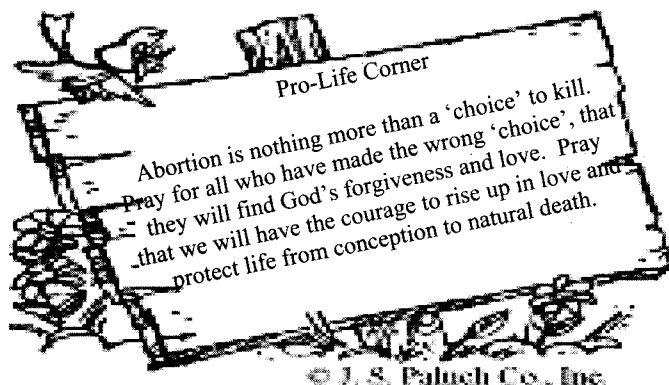
CHANGE A HEART
