WEEKEND OF REFLECTION

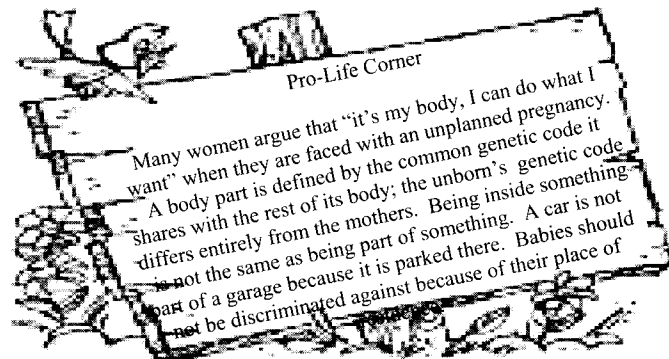
