LADIES FELLOWSHIP

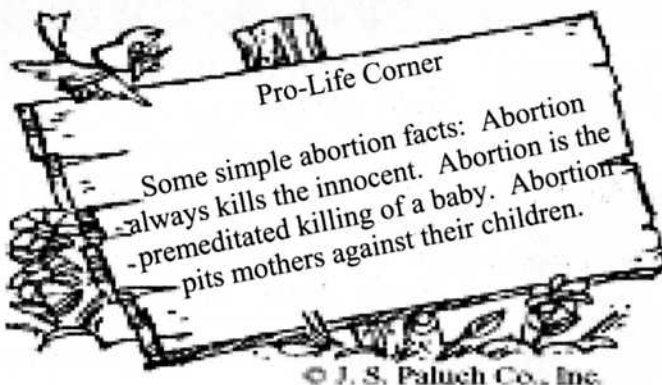
